- 4. Fireguard the area as required under the terms of the Wildfires Act _____(initial)
 - a. Fire to be surrounded by minimum six-meter-wide strip of land free of inflammable material
- 5. Burn during **daylight hours only**
- 6. No fire to be set with winds over 30 km/hr _____(initial)
- 7. **If I DO NOT complete planned burning within the 2-week period as indicated above I will reapply.**
